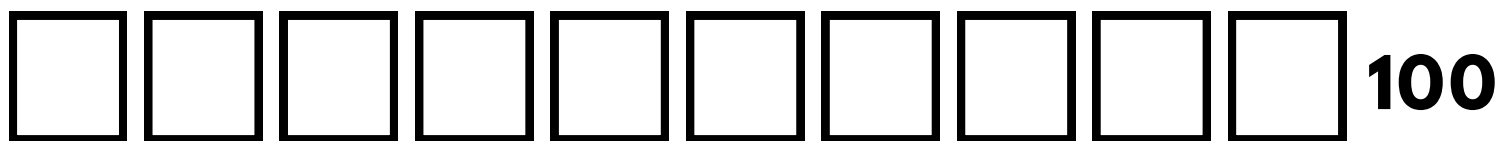
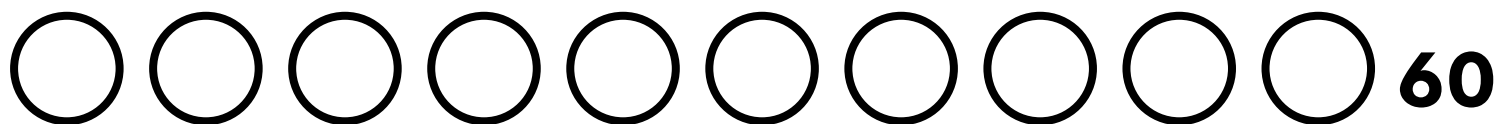
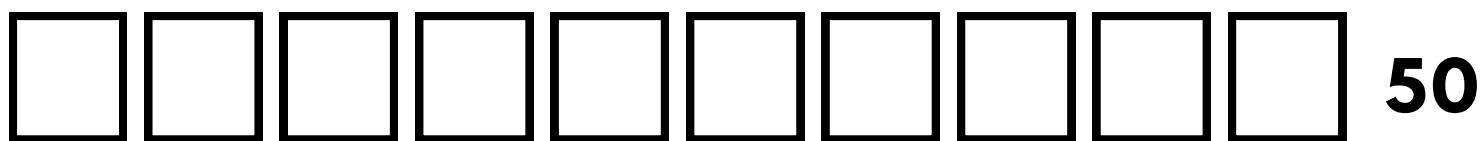
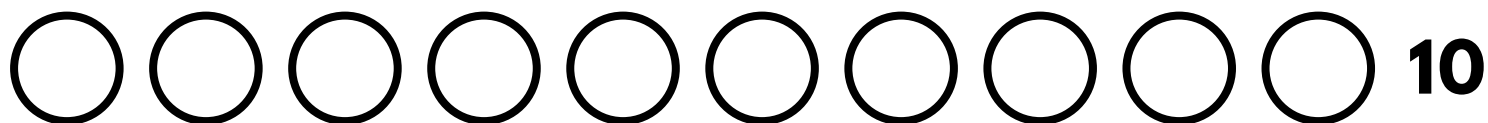
**Hooray! You just took an important step
