Singing: Watch a kids concert together like Raffi or attend a local library or other free musical event together.

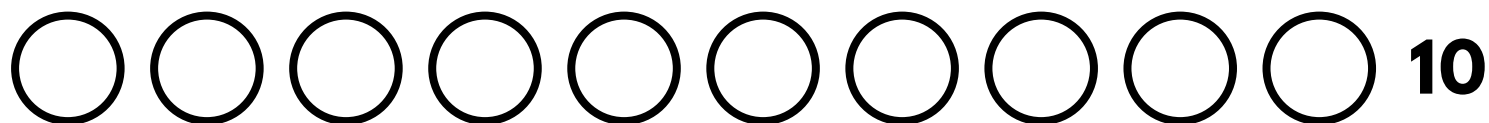
Writing: Make a sign for their room door or labels for their dollhouse or lego structure. Have written name cards for their favorite things.

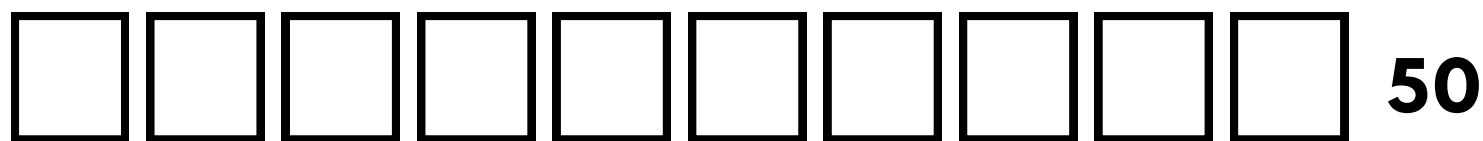
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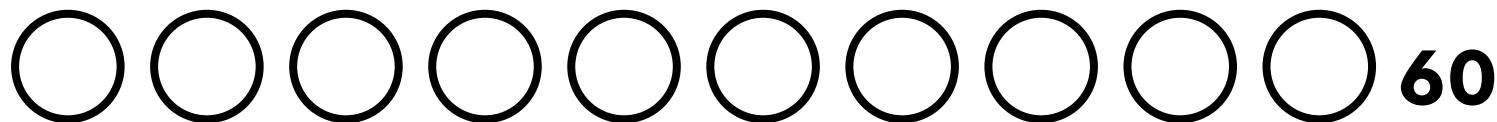
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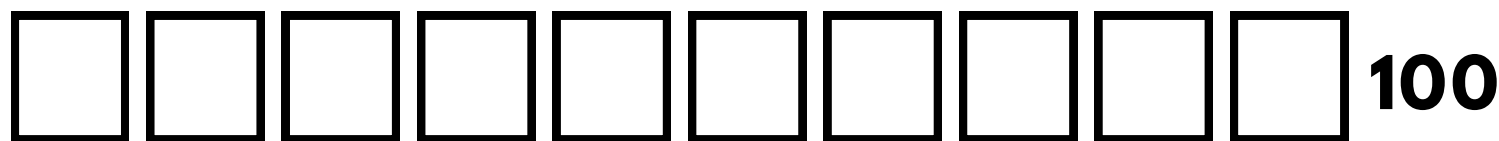
