- Reading:
  - Students, please complete the <u>reading assignment</u> (part of the quarter one grade)
  - Join Story Shares for free ebooks.
- Math
  - <u>Middle School Summer Math Doc</u> students are asked to sign into their iReady MyPath and **pass 1-2 lessons per week** (approximately 30-50 minutes)
  - Entering Algebra 1 Honors only click here for your work
